


## **Gender- Cross Cutting**

#### **Objectives**

- Inclusion- All targets and activities must include at least 40% of women beneficiaries. Women must be involved in the activities of the 3 value chains being strengthened
- Empowerment ADVANCE works in 4 of the 5 WEAI domains: production, income, resources and leadershipThe objective is to increase the empowerment of women in the 4 domains. When women are empowered to make the decision on input purchase, there is a 27% increase in the number who used non-saved seeds and a 58% increase of the ones who used fertilizer

## Use of ICTs

### **Objectives**

 Increase adoption of agricultural technologies i.e. agriculture tips through SMS, listenership clubs (solar radios), tablet with software to do extension

 Financial inclusion and reduce the need for cash for transactions: i.e. Mobile Money, promoted by the project, has facilitated transactions which include payment for inputs

## **Climate Smart Technologies**

#### Objectives

- Increase efficiency of the production systems despite the increase in environmental challenges (increase productivity with appropriate soil nutrition, dissemination of high yield varieties)
- Increase resilience as changes in environment will continue to occur and intensify (dissemination of drought tolerant varieties/hybrids, minimum-tillage to capture water and overcome dry spells, setting a monitoring system for Fall Armyworm to reduce impact of pest)

## Minimum-tillage

 Minimum-tillage is a technology that allows to increase resilience and efficiency
