Reach: 7 million youth in more than 50 countries, including 3.5 million girls







- Since 2013, 4-H Ghana has signed an MOU with AgriCorps, a US Non Profit Organization that recruits agriculture professionals to help build capacity within our 4-H programs. These volunteers who have gone through 4-H and FFA come with rich experiences in the value chain of agriculture and greatly impact our programmes.
- The AgriCorps Fellows are deployed in rural communities teaching agriculture science in schools and working with local farmers in communities to increase yield.
- Innovative programmes such as the Teacher Empowerment Trainings, PYD, LEAD Contest, and the Alumni Volunteer Network were introduced by AgriCorps Fellows working with 4-H Ghana.
