- B. Financial constraints resulting in poor remuneration/allowances/ motivation
- Lack of transportation to event centres

C. Abuse

- Verbal threats, insults, lack of respect
- Physical personal attacks/ destruction of equipment/gadgets/ Arrest

Challenges cont'd

- A. Poor Leadership/staff Strength
- Lack of continuous Training
- Lack of understanding of specialized fields/issues
- Failure to do follow-ups
- Lack of briefing for interviews

- B. Influence of people in higher Authority
- From Institutional to national levels
- Societal Pressure

Building Relations

This can be done through The establishment of a constant engagement to explain issues through:

- A. Visits to media officials
- B. Workshops to brief journalist on upcoming events
- C. Create a media list for easy contact
