

Intermediate Result 1.1

Outcomes IR 1.1

- Increased application of improved technologies and practices

- Increased availability and use of affordable/sustainable services
- Improved capacity of women and men to participate in markets
- Increased private investment to support value chain development

Intermediate Result 1.3 Strengthened Local Capacity


Outcomes IR 1.3

- Strengthened capacity to implement VC development and become eligible for USAID funding



- Collection by enumerators, under supervision by staff
- Entry by data imputers, under supervision by M&E Field Officers
- Storage on Sharepoint
- Analysis by Accra team DCoP M&E/DB Manager
- Reporting and sharing by DCoP M&E/M&E Coordinator
- Filing by M&E Field Officers
- Validation by M&E Officers, DB Manager, DCoP M&E

Databases - Sharepoint

- ACDI/VOCA worldwide database
- Online database system that allows an online and offline data entry, online sharing, storage and backup of the data
- Different types of access password protected
- Every edit recorded in a log file
- ADVANCE II SP set up from April 2014
- Following some practical issues (connectivity, high number of beneficiaries)
 → DCI Data Capture Interface
- Current content: loans, demo plots, profiles of input dealers and radio stations, FY14 training data, FY14 services tracker data, gross margin and end market surveys data

Databases - DCI

- Data Capture Interface
- Specifically developed for ADVANCE II
- For entry of profiling, training and services data
- Offline operations
- Includes a smart card system
- User friendly automated entry of training and services through card readers
- Password protected with different permission levels similar
- Sits in M&E staff and technical team's laptops
- Regular synchronization among the office's computers and with Accra office

Databases – Sales Tracker

- Designed for ADVANCE II
- Monitors services OBs provided to their OGs
- Business management tool for the OB
- Records all payments made and outstanding
- Generation of receipts and some simple reports
- Only for OBs that received a laptop for the others, services will be tracked through DCI
- Password protected with different permission levels

Data collection forms

- Based on data needs: reporting and project management
- Consistent with databases
- Surveys and routine
- Paper, offline and online
- Training on forms
- Tested

Best practices

- Involvement of management and technical staff
