BACKGROUND: HISTORICAL FOUNDATIONS

- In 2005 CARE asked VSL Associates to develop a simple Excel-based MIS. Shortly after its launched in 2006, Oxfam, Plan and CRS, funded its 2nd version, 6 countries.
- In 2008 Gates Foundation invested in SG projects implemented by CARE, Oxfam and CRS in 6 countries.
- Q2 of 2010, VSL Associates develop a web based SAVIX MIS as a means of tracking the performance of 42 projects.
- Today, 44 countries with 958 projects and **241,000 savings groups (SG), with a total membership of 5.27 million members.**

- The SAVIX is a reporting system that provides transparent and standardized data on community-managed microfinance.
- The SAVIX is available free on (www.mis.thesavix.org) and is fully functional as a stand-alone MIS solution for agencies that promote savings groups.
- The aim to: *increase awareness of SG scale, facilitate analysis, develop norms and improve performance operational practice by comparing project performance and reporting on long-term research findings.*
- The goal is: benchmarking and informed decision-making to achieve high-quality program results.

DIFFERENCES BETWEEN SAVIX MIS AND EXCEL MIS

SAVIX MIS	EXCEL MIS
<i>web-server based</i> , accessed from any location worldwide, by any number of authorised users, simultaneously.	Installed on a single computer at a single location, restricted to one user
Not restricted to a single Project, and an unlimited number of projects can be created under one MIS	Different Projects used separate instances of the MIS.
Most illogical data is rejected at the time of entry, eliminating the need for centralised screening	Most illogical data is rejected by manual screening which may passed unnoticed.
Projects that are in different MIS (and also in different countries) can be linked together in Networks.	This done manually
Aggregation and comparison of results in an unlimited number of projects is made easy and simple.	This done manually



BASIC ARCHITECTURE OF SAVIX MIS

The system operates at three different levels:

- **The MIS.** This is where the individual Project is created and its data stored. An MIS can house an unlimited number of Projects. The MIS Administrator is responsible for:
 - *creating the MIS*
 - *creating individual Projects*
 - *creating User-defined fields (in addition to standard fields) for data that will be asked of all Projects.*
- **The Project.** This is the basic unit of the MIS. It is where individual group data is entered and operational performance reports are generated. Each Project has its own Administrator (PA) and, optionally, its own Data Entry Officer (DEO).
- **The Network.** It is mainly used by international NGOs to consolidate all of their Savings Group Projects either regionally or worldwide, but can also be used in a single country to link together Projects that are being implemented by different partners, each of which has created its own MIS.

Management Information System



Read first: SAVIX Management Information System (explanation)

The Management Information System (MIS) allows Implementing Organizations to conveniently track a variety of Projects, as long as they are all in the same country and are implemented in the same currency.

A MIS is established by an MIS Administrator, who chooses the country and currency of the MIS (this cannot be changed later), and establishes at least one Project. The MIS Administrator will assign a Project Administrator to each Project at the time of setting up each Project in the MIS.

Most often MIS Administrators will be located in national offices, and Project Administrators will be located in sub-offices near to Project sites. Data entry is done at the Project level, and can be done by a Data Entry Officer with their own unique Username and password, or by a Project Administrator. MIS Administrators do not enter data into Projects.MIS

Administrators have the option to establish User-defined datafields. If they choose to do this, all Projects within that MIS will see those User-defined datafields. If the fields are made mandatory, all Projects will need to enter that data in order to save Group records.

To start using the Management Information System (MIS) you must register with a valid E-mail address and establish a password. You must also choose a unique name for your MIS, based on your organization name.

The MIS Administrator may find that the e-mail appears in junk, because this will depend on server settings. If this is the case, restore the e-mail to the Inbox and then click on the long URL (1) that identifies the MIS (in this case VSL Associates Tanzania).

Once the MIS Administrator clicks on the URL, the system will automatically take the MIS Administrator to the MIS home page, where (s)he will be able to initiate the setup sequence. This involves all of the necessary steps needed in setting up the MIS and creating the first Project.
